Commonwealth War Graves Commission

The Commonwealth War Graves Commission (CWGC) is responsible for maintaining commemorations at two locations in Dominica: Roseau Roman Catholic Cemetery and Roseau Public Cemetery. There are three Commonwealth burials in total in Dominica, all dating to the Second World War; one at Roseau Public Cemetery and two at Roseau Roman Catholic Cemetery.

**ROSEAU PUBLIC CEMETERY, Dominica  
Commonwealth War Dead (1939-1945)**

**BRIGGS**, Private, LLOYD, L/SCA/7135. Windward Islands Bn., South Caribbean Force. 20 February 1944. Age 17. Son of Lloyd F.H. and Elaine Briggs, of St. George's, Grenada.

**ROSEAU ROMAN CATHOLIC CEMETERY, Dominica  
Commonwealth War Dead (1939-1945)**

**BOUGOUNEAU**, Private, M, L/SCA/7096. Windward Islands Bn., South Caribbean Force. 12 May 1944. Age 25. Son of Raymond and Emine Bougouneau, of La Plaine, Dominica.

**LEWIS**, Lance Corporal, ALLEYNE, L/SCA/7156. Windward Islands Bn., South Caribbean Force. 18 February 1944. Age 23. Son of Arthur and Eliza Lewis, of Barbay, St. Johns, Grenada.

Commonwealth War Dead (1939-1945)**

**COOKMAN**, Leading Aircraftman, BASIL THORNTON, 1212798. Royal Air Force Volunteer Reserve. 7 October 1943. Age 38. Son of Dr. N. G. Cookman, and of Mrs. L. K. T. Cookman, of Dominica. Grave Reference: 12. C. 31.

**ALEXANDRIA (HADRA) WAR MEMORIAL CEMETERY, Egypt  
Commonwealth War Dead (1914-1918)**

**PATRICE**, Private, DONALD JOSEPH, 1239. 2nd Bn., British West Indies Regiment. 15 March 1919. Age 20. Son of Alexander Patrice and Alice Nicholas, his wife, of Roseau, Dominica, British West Indies. Grave Reference: C. 208.

**KANTARA WAR MEMORIAL CEMETERY, Egypt**

**Commonwealth War Dead (1914-1918)**

**JAMES**, Private, TARBET, 1191. 2nd Bn., British West Indies Regiment. 28 September 1917. Age 22. Son of Elish and Maria James, of Marigot, Dominica, B.W.I. Grave Reference: E. 447.

**ARRAS MEMORIAL, Pas de Calais, France**

**Commonwealth War Dead (1914-1918)**

**ARIZA**, Private, FRANCISCO A., G/25074. 19th Bn., Middlesex Regiment. 24 March 1918. Age 22. Son of Jose del Carmen Ariza, of Puerto Plata, Dominican Republic, West Indies; husband of M. Ariza, of Port Deposit, Maryland, U.S.A. Grave Reference: Bay 7.

**LEWIS**, Private, SILVEY MERCULIA, 11373. 8th Bn., British West Indies Regiment. Died of pneumonia, 7 December 1917. Age 23. Son of Matthias Lewis and Ann Dorset (his wife), of Weirs, Marigot, Dominica, British West Indies. Grave Reference: II. C. 10.

**ST. SEVER CEMETERY EXTENSION, ROUEN, Seine-Maritime, France**

**Commonwealth War Dead (1939-1945)**

**BRYANT**, Flying Officer, (Air Gunner), HAROLD CHERBERD, 143598. D F C. 514 Sqdn., Royal Air Force Volunteer Reserve. 2 May 1944. Age 32. Son of Gerald King Bryant and Helen Bryant, of Dominica. Grave Reference: Block "S". Plot 4. Row U. Coll. grave 8-14.

**ALLEYNE**, Sergeant, OSMUND WILLIAM St. CLAIR, 1393814. 142 Sqdn., Royal Air Force Volunteer Reserve. 5 August 1943. Of Dominica. Grave Reference: Panel 8, Column 1.

**McCOY**, Pilot Officer, LACOMBE ALPHONSUS, 130839. Royal Air Force Volunteer Reserve. 11 April 1943. Of Dominica. Grave Reference: Panel 7, Column 1.

**SINGAPORE MEMORIAL, Singapore**

**Commonwealth War Dead (1939-1945)**

**DELLIS**, Flight Sergeant, DONALD LIVINGSTONE, R/217478. 357 (R.A.F.) Sqdn, Royal Canadian Air Force. 6 June 1945. Age 21. Son of Mr. and Mrs. George Dellis, of San Pedro de Macoris, Dominican Republic. Grave Reference: Column 458.

**CHOC BAY WAR CEMETERY, St. Lucia**  
**Commonwealth War Dead (1939-1945)**

**DAVID**, Private, T, L/SCA/7599. Windward Islands Bn., South Caribbean Force. 6 November 1944. Age 23. Son of Simon and Delta David, of St. Pauls, Mahout, Dominica. Grave Reference: Row A. Grave 10.

**TOWER HILL MEMORIAL, London, United Kingdom**  
**Commonwealth War Dead (1914-1918)**

**BEAUPIERRE**, Ship's Cook, JOSEPH. S.S. "Zillah" (London), Mercantile Marine. Drowned, as a result of an attack by an enemy submarine, 22 October 1917. Age 25. Son of the late Frederick and Mary Sainte John Beaupierre. Born at Dominica, British West Indies.

**NICHOLAS**, Fireman and Trimmer, ALEXANDER. S.S."Dundee", Mercantile Marine. 31 January 1917. Age 45. Born in Dominica.

**ROSE**, Sailor, JAMES S.. S.S. "Landonia" (London), Mercantile Marine. Drowned, as a result of an attack by an enemy submarine, 21 April 1918. Age 25. Born in Dominica.
