JOHN STAPLES MOLESWORTH LENOX- CONYNGHAM

Cdg. 6th Bn., Connaught Rangers who died on 03 September 1916 Age 54

Third son of Sir Wm. F. Lenox-Conyngham, K.C.B., of Spring Hill, Moneymore, Co. Londonderry; husband of Violet Lenox-Conyngham (nee Donaldson). Served with 1st and 2nd Bn. Connaught Rangers from 1881 to 1911; recalled Oct. 1914, to command 6th Bn., which he trained from its beginning. Proceeded to France, Oct. 1915.
