412 Sqdn., Royal Canadian Air Force who died on 11 December 1941 Age 19

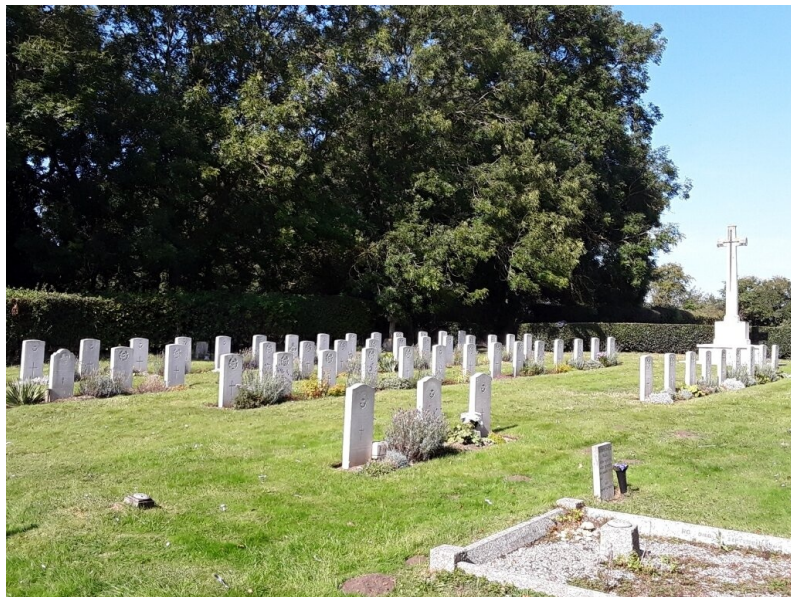
